Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that:

- A school uniform promotes a sense of pride in the Academy
- Creates a feeling of community and belonging
- Raises the profile of the Academy within in the local community and beyond

- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children within our Academy
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance as everyone has the same

We appreciate parental support to uphold the uniform policy.

This year, there has been some relaxation to our uniform policy in light of the Covid pandemic having impact on availability and access to some items.

From September 2021, we will be working to the requirements of our uniform policy. We have shared these expectations below and trust that you can source the appropriate items during the school holidays.





For PE, children should change in to:	
	White t shirt A close fitting, round neck t-shirt is perfect
	Dark PE shorts
	Where possible, PE sessions will be held outdoors. For this, children may wear dark coloured joggers and top.
	Children should wear trainers or pumps for PE. This should be a change of footwear from the footwear that they wear to school each day.
PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY NAMED.	
Children will be asked to change back in to their uniform at the end of the school day.
